The VSCCA is strictly an amateur racing group, keeping its emphasis on history and car preservation. The Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix is one of the highlights of our busy event calendar. Racers come from all over the US, even Europe, to race an amazing assortment of vintage cars in front of 200,000+ spectators. In the 27 years it has run, PVGP has matured into a world-

class event and raised over \$1.5 million for its two charities. While most of each car's entry fee goes to the charities, VSCCA strives to make an even greater contribution.

In 2007, we initiated a "sponsorship" program for drivers, who have since raised an additional \$25,000 to benefit some truly wonderful people.
